FOR FAMILIES

Operating Hours, Fees & Charges

Operating hours: 6.00am to 6.00pm.

The service opens at 6.00am - Children cannot be 'Signed In' before 6.00am due to licensing requirements (time displayed on kiosk). The service closes at 6.00pm. After 6.00pm, a late fee of \$20 will incur for the first 15 minutes and \$1 per minute thereafter (per child).

In service day: \$73 (excluding CCS)

Incursion Day: \$93 (excluding CCS)

Excursion Day: \$104 (excluding CCS)

Medication

All medication is to be given to an educator as they will administer the medication. Medication must be pharmacy labelled, in date and a medication form must be completed at the service. A current action plan (within 1 year) may be required prior to commencement of care.

Bookings

All Vacation Care bookings and absences are made in OWNA. Please note, one weeks' notice is required to cancel sessions without charge. If a session is full, please select the bell icon in OWNA to be notified of availability.

Excursions

Please be aware of the time you are required to arrive at the service - per the program. Please ensure each child brings lunch, a hat and water bottle. All children will be required to wear an excursion shirt as part of our risk assessment (provided on the day). Each excursion requires a signed permission form beforehand (completed digitally in OWNA). Children are not permitted to bring money for purchases as educators are unable to facilitate this.

Please note that on **split excursion days, children must attend with their allocated age group only**. Children cannot swap groups or choose to attend the excursion/service program assigned to a different year level group.

Food & Clothing

Breakfast is provided from 6.30am until 8.00am - with a variety of cereals, toast and/or seasonal fruit.

The service will provide morning and afternoon tea (as per our menu). Children are required to bring a nutritional lunch each day during Vacation Care ('nut free'). If children do not have lunch, requiring the service to provide, a \$5 charge will be incurred.

Children are required to wear **enclosed shoes** and **sun smart and appropriate clothing** each day (school uniform discouraged - no singlets or midriff tops). Sunscreen (Coles SPF 50+) will be applied every two hours as per our sun safety policy (please supply own sunscreen if unable to use Coles brand). A spare change of clothes is also recommended in the case of unforeseen circumstances.

Each day, please ensure your child brings: a hat, water bottle, packed lunch & spare clothes.
